Take I-29 South to I-680 North, then proceed to take the first exit in Nebraska just over the river, which is 30th St. Turn left on 30th St, and stay in the left lane and proceed to the first intersection (Dick Collins Road). Turn left at Dick Collins Road, and proceed to the “T” in the road. Turn left onto John J. Pershing Dr; follow signs in to the park to show site.

From the West (Lincoln, NE)

I-80 East to I-680 North to 30th St exit, turn right onto 30th St. Immediately get into the far left lane, proceed to the first intersection (Dick Collins Road). Turn left at Dick Collins Road, and proceed to the “T” in the road. Turn left onto John J. Pershing Dr; follow signs into the park to show site.

From the South (Kansas City, MO)

I-29 North to I-680 West, proceed to first exit in Nebraska just over the river, which is 30th St, stay in left lane, proceed to first intersection (Dick Collins Road). Turn left at Dick Collins Road, and proceed to the “T” in the road. Turn left onto John J. Pershing Dr; Follow signs into the park to show site.

From the East (Des Moines, IA)

I-80 West to I-29 South and then to I-680 West, then proceed to take the first exit in Nebraska just over the river, which is 30th St. Turn left on 30th St, and stay in the left lane and proceed to the first intersection (Dick Collins Road). The following ORIGINAL documents must be submitted to the BST Secretary on the day of the Breed Test. Entry into the BST will not be accepted without presenting these originals prior to taking the test.

- USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler
- A copy of the membership card will be accepted on the day of the show.
- This exception to the original document requirements applies to the membership cards only.
- USRC Registration Certificate for the dog being entered.
- Scorebook showing titles earned, (minimum BH) scorebook number and full name of dog.
- USRC recognized Hip Certification.
- Prior BST attempts.
- Weight certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
- A copy of the USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as a proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION

1. Dogs born after June 1, 1999 in countries with anti-docking laws must be shown with a natural tail.
2. The BST will be conducted according to the USRC regulations.
3. The judgment of the Kormeister or Judge is final. No appeals are possible.
4. **Copies of required documentation for the BST, Champion, Working and USRC Sieger Classes must be submitted with entry and Originals must be brought to the show and be available for inspection before entering the ring.**
5. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.
6. Dogs with restricted USRC registrations or AKC limited registrations may not enter a USRC show.

7. Spayed or neutered dogs may not enter a USRC BST or show with the exceptions of Veteran, Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Classes.
8. Effective Jan 1, 1998, all dogs competing for a Sieger or Siegerin Title must be registered with USRC. Dogs not registered with USRC prior to the show may compete for a Sieger or Siegerin Title after completion of an On Site Show Registration at the show.
9. Effective Jan 1, 2000, all dogs entering a Brood Bitch or Stud Dog class must have a USRC Recognized Breed Test.
10. If a valid Hip Certification number is not provided on the entry form dogs over 30 months of age, the number '0' (zero) will be printed in the hip rating section.
11. Dogs with missing teeth will be excused from the ring.
12. Males be judged first.
13. Dogs are shown in natural stance; no hand stacking is allowed.
14. Any entry that does not meet the Class or BST requirements will be invalid.
15. The host club shall not permit entry into any class or BST if an entered dog's original registration and support documents of all certifications, accomplishments and titles are not available at the show for inspection at the time of the class.
16. Once a dog is eligible for the Champion, Working or Sieger/Siegerin Class, the dog may not enter the Open Class. When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry.
17. Once a dog is eligible for the USRC Sieger/Siegerin Class they may not enter the Open, Champion or Working Class; however the dog may enter the Veteran Class if age permits.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

1. This is a German style show.
2. Event is being held outside, rain or shine.
3. No dogs are allowed to be tied out at the show-site or ringside.
4. Please use designate areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them.
5. Adult classes will be moved long enough for the judge to evaluate the movement and fitness. You may change handlers as needed.
6. Dress is informal wear, comfortable shoes and clothing.
7. Bring your own chairs and anything else you deem necessary for you and your dog's comfort. Shade is limited so you may want to bring shade for you dogs.

IMPORTANT
Breed Suitability Test Information

The Breed Suitability Test (BST) is designed to select those Rottweilers that are worth of being bred. The dog's conformation must be judged of breeding quality and free of disqualifying faults. The dog must have a valid hip certification and have a tattoo for identification. Once the conformation and soundness qualifications have been met, the dog's temperament is tested. This test includes a gun sureness test, a protection test, and a test to insure that the dog is stable around the public. The United States Rottweiler Club strongly believes that these test are vital to maintain the Rottweiler in type and temperament should be the cornerstone of any breeding program.

BST Prerequisites for Owners, Handlers & dogs

1. The judgment of the Kormeister or Judge is final. No appeals are possible.
2. Dogs born in countries where docking is forbidden by law, shall be shown with the tail left in its natural state.
3. This rule shall be effective for all dogs born on or after June 1, 1999.
4. There shall be no preference in critiquing dogs with docked tails or for dogs with tails left in the natural state.
5. If a dog is presented at the BST and has a tail, which has been cut in violation of these rules, the dog shall not be allowed to test.

6. BST critiques are not official until checked, reordered and signed by the Head Breed Warden and/or the Administrator of Records. After the BST's are approved, the original copy will be forwarded to the dog owner.
7. The BST paperwork must be complete and available for inspection on the day of the test. If this is not done, the BST will not be signed and will be deemed invalid. The Dog may retest..
8. Both the owner and handler must be USRC members.
9. The owner and/or handler of any damage caused by his or her dog.
10. The dogs must be registered with USRC by the entry closing date.
11. The dog must have a USRC recognized hip certification
12. The dog must have passed the Schutzhund BH.
13. The entry form for the BST must be sent to the Host Club before the entry closing date.

Show Information

This show will be officiated by an international breed judge. Judging will be under international rules. Classes will be moved long enough for the judge to evaluate each dog's movement. Additional handlers will be allowed to move and show the dog.

The USRC Sieger and Siegerin Title represent the combination of working ability and beauty. The USRC only awards this title at a National or Regional Sieger Show. A true champion must meet certain requirements in temperaments as well as structure. To be eligible to compete in this class a dog must possess at least a Schutzhund 1 or IPO 1 title and must have passed a USRC recognized Breed Suitability Test. The dog must also have a USRC recognized hip rating and have earned a "V" rating on that day.

***Note: All entries for Sieger and Working classes must have documented proof of titles**

- USRC Sieger/Siegerin Title
The USRC Sieger and Siegerin Title represent the combination of working ability and beauty. The USRC only awards this title at a National or Regional Sieger Show. A true champion must meet certain requirements in temperaments as well as structure. To be eligible to compete in this class a dog must possess at least a Schutzhund 1 or IPO 1 title and must have

passed a USRC recognized Breed Suitability Test. The dog must also have a USRC recognized hip rating and have earned a “V” rating on that day.

G. Classes

- 1. Puppy Classes**
4-6 Month Male/Female (option) For all Rotweilers between the ages of 4-6 months
6-9 Month Male/Female For all Rotweilers between the ages of 6-9 months
9-12 Month Male/Female For all Rotweilers between the age of 9-12months
- 2. Youth Classes**
12-18 Month Male/Female For all Rotweilers between the age of 12-18 months
18-24 Month Male/Female For all Rotweilers between the age of 18-24 months
- 3. Adult Classes**
Open Male/Female For all Rottweilers 24 months and older without a Schutzhund or IPO title, Championship or Sieger/Siegerin title.
Champion Male/Female For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Championship. This includes AKC and CKC Champions, International FCI Champions and any champion of Record from a country whose Championship was awarded by an FCI recognized kennel club. (see FCI recognized kennel club list)
Working Male/Female For all Rottweilers 24 months and older with a Schutzhund or IPO title that have not earned a Sieger or Siegerin title
Veteran Male/Female (optional) For all Rottweilers 7 years or older on the day of the show.
Sieger/Siegerin Class For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Sieger or Siegerin title. This includes USRC National or Regional Sieger, the World, Europa, Bundesiege or ADRK Klub Sieger Show. Dogs eligible to enter the Sieger or Siegerin class may not enter the Open, Champion or Working class however, the dog may enter the Veteran Class if age permits.
- 4. Non-Regular Classes**
Kennel Group (optional) Entered by the Kennel owner. Three or more dogs bred by the Kennel Owner and registered with the Kennel Name of the entrant. The Kennel Owner need not be the registered owner of the dogs. All dogs must first be entered in the show’s regular classes. Written critiques are not given.
Brood Bitch (optional) Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. The brood bitch and at least two of her produce must appear in the ring. The bitch must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. The produce must first be entered in the show’s regular classes. Written critiques are not given.
Stud Dog (optional) Entered by the owner of the stud dog. The stud dog and at least two of his get must appear in the ring. The dog

must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. The get must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Once a dog is eligible for the Champion, Working or Sieger/Siegerin class, the dog may not enter the Open Class. When a dog is eligible of more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. If a dog is eligible for the Sieger or Siegerin Class the dog may not be entered in any other class except Veteran.

5. Additional classes may not be offered without prior approval from the Regional Director.
6. Clubs must assure the dogs born in countries where docking is forbidden by law, shall be shown with the tail left in its natural state.
7. This rule shall be effective for all dogs born on or after June 1, 1999.
8. There shall be no preference in conformation shows for dogs with docked tails or for dogs with tails left in the natural state.
9. If a dog is presented at a show and has a tail, which has been cut in violation of these rules, the dog shall not be allowed to be shown.

H. Show Procedure

1. Each day, all dog classes go first, then all Female classes.
2. Prior to the judging of the Working and Sieger classes, awarding the Sieger/Siegerin title and the Breed Suitability Test, the paragraphs defining the requirements and purpose of these classes and titles must be read.
3. A handler may request that a dog be moved to the Champion, Working or Sieger class after the close of entries. This is only possible if the dog is already entered in the show catalog. Original documents, supporting the move to a different class entry, must be presented to the Show Secretary. This must be done prior to the start of class in which the dog was originally entered. A copy of the paperwork should be brought to the show site and be given to the Show Secretary for club files.
4. Regional and National Sieger Shows will be conducted in the following 2-day

order:

Day 1- All Male classes through 18 or 24 months
All Female classes through 18 or 24 months
USRC Best Puppy Male/Female
USRC Youth Sieger/Siegerin

Day 2- All Male classes through 24 months (if not held on Day 1)
All Open, Champion, Working, Veteran (if offered), and Sieger class
All Non-Regular classes (if offered)
USRC Youth Sieger/Siegerin (if not held on Day 1)
USRC Sieger/ Siegerin

5. The following awards shall be given:
 - a. Best Puppy Male/Female. Chosen from the class winners up to 12 months.
 - b. USRC Youth Sieger/Siegerin. Chosen from the class winners of the 12-18 and 18-24 month classes.
 - c. USRC Sieger/Siegerin. Chosen from the eligible winners of the Champion, Working, Veteran (if offered), Sieger/ Siegerin Classes.
 - d. To be eligible to compete for Sieger or Siegerin the dog must have:
 - * A valid USRC registration or must have applied for registration at the

show

equivalent * A minimum of a Schutzhund 1 or IPO 1 title or USRC recognized

- * A valid USRC recognized Breed Test.
- * Received a V-Rating in the class on the day of the show

6. It is the Show Secretary/Chairman's responsibility to check all dog's paperwork and determine which dogs are eligible for the Sieger and Siegerin title. They must ensure that only dogs meeting the Sieger/Siegerin requirements are brought into the ring for final judging.
7. The judge may select the winner from the eligible dogs. If no dogs fulfill the requirements for the Sieger/Siegerin title no dogs will be brought into the show ring and no title will be awarded.
8. The judge may also withhold the title.

Trophies for First Place in Each Class
Trophies for Youth Sieger, and Youth Siegerin
Trophies for Best Puppy Male and Female
Trophies for Most Beautiful Male and Female in Show

On both Saturday and Sunday afternoon, the critiques and trophies will be presented following the judge. If for any reason you cannot stay for the Awards Presentation and no one will be able to pick up for you, you can provide a self-addressed stamped 9x12 envelope. (If not, the critiques will not be forwarded!)
